

As you are likely aware, at 12:01 a.m. Saturday May 9<sup>th</sup>, those counties which extended Stay at Home will transition to the Colorado Safer at Home phase, as detailed in the Public Health Order 20-28.

We want to provide you as many resources as possible as you prepare for this next phase. It is extremely important for you to know the guidelines for the specific county you are working in, as there are some stricter rules at the county level. If the county is stricter, it supersedes the state order. In NO circumstance may a city or county make orders that are not as strict as the state.

REALTORS<sup>®</sup> behavior in this next phase will determine the ability to continue to conduct business during this crisis. Please know that the public is watching and reporting violations, perceived or otherwise. REALTORS<sup>®</sup> have a huge responsibility to be observant of the Health Order and keep clients and the public safe. Keep in mind not only the letter of the Order but also the intent.

We are including a [sample log](#) that you may use as you wish as regardless of the county, you must maintain a record of showings at every listing. There are two worksheets in the workbook, one for the listing agent and one for the showing agent. Again, just a sample to get you started. Reports from showing services may also serve as logs provided that all the required information is documented.
